Project brief

As part of construction works at Waterloo Station, platforms were realigned to cater for longer trains. Toppesfield provided Walkers Construction with resurfacing services.

Toppesfield resolved logistical difficulties caused by no direct-level access to the site. All materials were wheelbarrowed from delivery points on the street up via lift shifts to the platforms.

A weight restriction on the platforms limited the size of machinery that Toppesfield could use. This was no issue, the company was able to choose one of its own smaller rollers from its larger fleet of plant.

Delivery

- One week
- Included 24 hour working windows
- 180t AC 6 Dense Surface Course
- All operatives already Personal Track Safety trained

Achievements

- **Toppesfield accommodated the client’s request to work 24 hours in order to complete the works quicker than intended**
- **Finished on time within the allocated programme duration of the August Blockade**
- **Zero accidents**
- **Defect free**
